

Country Report 6th Grade

Purpose - The purpose of this project is to allow students to learn more information about a specific country, including landforms, customs, traditions, history, economy, etc.

Directions - Each student will be able to choose one country to do a report on, no student will be able to choose the same country as another student. Students will choose in a random order their country. Each student is to do their own work on the report, (parents may help with the project, but please remember that this is the students report, they will only learn if they do the work.)

Students will complete the report in stages. We will go over in class each specific item as well as spending class time in the computer lab and library for research.

Stage 1 - Note Cards – Students will research information on their country. Research may include information on landforms, customs, history, economy, everyday life, etc. Notes taken will be placed on index cards. The note cards will be collected and graded, on neatness, content, and information.

Stage 2 – Outline – Students will complete an outline putting their information in order. The outlines will be collected and graded

Stage 3 - Rough Draft – Students will complete a rough draft of the report. The rough draft will be collected.

Stage 4 – Final Draft – Students will complete a final draft of the report. The final draft must be a minimum of 4 pages typed double spaced, 12 point, Times New Roman font. Completed with title page, outline, and bibliography (these do not count towards the 4 pages.)

Stage 5 – Oral Presentation – Students will orally present their country in front of class. Grading will be determined by, information given and presentation.
